#### **GAINSBOROUGH**

Gainsborough is a market town brimming with history, with roots dating back to the 9th century. Incredibly, it was the capital of England for 40 days and boasts significant industrial heritage. Gainsborough's fascinating story is waiting to be told.

#### **GAINSBOROUGH OLD HALL**

The jewel in the crown is the towns immaculately preserved medieval manor house dating from the 15th century. It boasts a succession of famous visitors, including Richard III and Henry VIII. Wander the corridors or take a tour with one of their knowledgeable volunteers.

### **ALL SAINTS PARISH CHURCH**

#### **GAINSBOROUGH UNITED** REFORMED CHURCH

Built as a memorial to John Robinson, Pastor to the Mayflower Pilgrims, the church houses an impressive display of the local history of the area's Separatist ancestors, who played an important role in the Mayflower voyage in 1620.
