Market Rasen, sitting on the edge of the Lincolnshire Wolds, is a historic market town offering an abundance of walking and cycling routes as well as activities for all to enjoy.

There are 5 walking routes that start within Market Rasen, ranging from 3.5 miles and 10.4 miles. Most of these walks can be adapted to be shortened or made longer, depending on the time available and ability.

- 3 Following Woods and Mills
- 4 Walks in Woods
- 5 From Cricket Fields to Green Lanes

Two routes have been developed by Cycle Lincolnshire exploring the Edge of the Lincolnshire Wolds. Starting in Market Rasen, both routes have opportunities to be shortened at various points or can be combined to do one large figure of 8.

1 Market Rasen to Caistor (33.5m / 54km)

Market Rasen to Wickenby (25m / 40km)
